TARRYTOWN PARKING UPDATES:

Did you know that yearly Merchant Parking Permits are available for purchase at Village Hall?

Did you know that the Village with the encouragement of the Merchants' Council is exploring options with a valet company to offer valet services on Main Street on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights? A couple of municipal lots are being explored for this usage.

Did you know that the Village is researching the implementation of "Pay by Phone" for parking purposes?

Did you know that the Village is involved in the Eminent Domain process with Citibank to acquire 21 parking spaces in that lot for municipal parking?

Did you know that there are currently 5 municipal parking lots in the business district area of Tarrytown?

1. Mckeel Avenue Lot
2. South Broadway Lot
3. West Elizabeth Street Lot
4. South Washington Street Lot - East side
5. South Washington Street Lot - West side

Did you know that the village is implementing a program to letter parking lots and to place a map with the parking lots on the Village website? The Village is first completing this work for the parking lots in the train station area and later in the downtown parking lots.

Did you know that all of the parking lots in the railroad station area are now metered and both residents and non-residents may park in these lots all week long subject to time restrictions (after certain hours)? On weekends, these parking lots are free of charge with no time restriction as to when the parking lots are available.

Did you know that parking lots in the railroad station area are available to residents for free after 2:00 PM? All the resident needs to do is to obtain a permit from the Parks and Recreation Department.

Did you know that the Tarrytown Merchants' Council has been working tirelessly alongside the Village to explore and create viable parking solutions for the betterment of the community at large? We continue to attempt to engage the ownership of the CVS LOT in dialogue with us to achieve some of these solutions.
